SUMMARY: This painting is overall in excellent condition. The surface exhibits minor signs of craquelure, as well as visible stretcher marks, but the surface is otherwise bright and clean. Under UV Scattered spots of inpainting are evident, primarily concentrated in the horseman with spots in the sky to the right and in the bottom right. The lower third of the canvas fluoresces under UV, which may indicate some overpainting. The gilt frame shows signs of general wear and tear, as well as splitting in the corners, but it is stable and otherwise in excellent condition.
