SUMMARY: Overall this painting is in excellent condition. The surface exhibits scattered craquelure, concentrated in the sky, as well as a few small spots of staining, but is otherwise bright and clear. Under UV there is no evidence of inpainting or overpainting; however a small patch of staining is evident in the bottom right corner. The gilt frame appears to be original and shows signs of general wear and tear, splitting in the corners, and a bit of loss on the inside right edge; however it is stable and otherwise in good condition.
